DECEMBER 2008 | ISRAELI MINISTERIES – ENERGY RELATED UPDATES

Ministry of the Environment

A report on air quality in Israel published by the Environmental Protection Ministry shows that air pollution in Israel poses a serious threat to health, even though a number of power stations have started using natural gas. The report points to an exceptional rise in the concentration of pollutant particles with a deviation of between 120-187% from the legal limit. Near main traffic arteries the deviations exceeded the limit by 200%

Ministry of National Infrastructure

The Director General of the MNI has stated that Israel will have no choice but to buy further quantities of natural gas since consumption is growing steadily, especially by Israel Electric Corporation and that diesel fuel is not an acceptable alternative

A report prepared by an international company for the MNI states that the fastest and cheapest solution for Israel's electricity sector is to set up a nuclear power station

The tender committee of the MNI chose Advantica to write the new natural gas masterplan to be updated up to 2020. The masterplan is to include developments in the transmission line, the penetration of new gas suppliers, issues regarding LNG and IPPs
