Delek IPP

- Delek infrastructure fully owned by Delek Group has entered into an agreement with Tnuva to set up a 55 MW cogeneration IPP for a total of \$63 million. The station is to be established on Tnuva's premises in Alon Tavor. The IPP will be owned jointly by Delek (57%) and Sigma and is planning to start operations in 2011.

Dorad

- Dorad was the only IPP project that responded to Mekorot's tender to supply electricity to the national water carrier.

Agan Chemicals

- The Interior Committee of the Knesset approved the established of a 53 MW gas generated IPP at the Agan Chemicals Industrial plant in Ashdod.
