- MNI Director General Hezi Kugler has met with Steven Johnson the head of the US Department of Environmental Protection together with the US Ambassador to Israel. Kugler discussed issues of security of energy supply and explained that all future coal stations would be based on clean technology (IGCC). Johnson explained that in the future the US intended basing 50% of the country's generation capacity on coal, similar to Israel, explaining that due to issues of security of supply the US could not afford to run away from coal. The two also discussed renewal energy and the costs to the economy of emissions for the generation of electricity.
